While we are unable to guarantee there will not be competing vendors, we will take this into consideration as we receive vendor applications.

Submitting an application with payment will ensure consideration for a space at the festival, but does not constitute a contractual agreement or acceptance. All applicants will be notified regarding their application status on an ongoing basis, as they are received. Green Chimneys reserves the right to turn down applications (and return fees) based on the number of applications received and overall variety of the menus.

Vendor Information

Food Trucks will be provided spaces based upon space requirements and/or their order of arrival. Food trucks must plan on being at the event for the entire day, from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The event will be held rain or shine. Post all prices for items at your food truck. Green Chimneys will promote participating food trucks.

Set-up, Hours, Teardown

Set-up time is between 7 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. only. Food Trucks will open at 10:00 a.m. and will remain open until 4:30 p.m. There will be no moving vehicles permitted onsite after 9:30am or prior to 4:30pm. All food vendors are required to remove their own trash and all unsold goods between the hours of 4:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Nothing is to be left behind on Green Chimneys premises. All non-essential vehicles must be parked in the Llama Lot, the vendor parking lot, with a parking pass provided by Green Chimneys.

On-Site Resources

All food trucks must be able to operate independently of any provided resources including water, electrical, refrigeration and any materials. We will provide the most level ground available, but our campus is not a traditional fairground. A quick site survey is encouraged. Vendors are responsible for all set-up and clean-up of their space.
