

Tips for Interviewing Virtually at Green Chimneys

- Get familiar with the technology. Make sure you've downloaded Zoom to your computer or mobile device well in advance of your interview. For instructions on how to sign up for a free Zoom account and download the app, please watch this <u>YouTube video</u>.
- Make sure that you received the interview link from Green Chimneys in your email so that you are ready and on time for your interview.
- Be well groomed and dress based upon the position you are applying for.
- Remember that in a Zoom interview the employer can see your expressions.
- Talk clearly and loudly so that you can be heard.
- Plan in advance where you'll be for your interview. Find a quiet place that will be free of interruption.
- It is better to use a computer however, if you choose to use your phone, make sure you download the app ahead of time and remain stationary during the interview. Have your phone charged.
- Come with questions prepared.
