

## Remote Learning Plan

Green Chimneys will have students whose families have made a decision to attend school this fall remotely. The plan below describes what remote learning will look like and given the possibility that communities may experience spikes in COVID-19 cases at any point during the school year, which may prompt short- or long-term school closures, we have developed a learning model and schedule that can continue as a remote environment for all students if the need arises.

This remote instruction will not only focus on “core” academic subject areas but also special programs such as Farm Science, Wildlife, Music and Art. All instruction will continue to be aligned with the New York State Learning Standards.

To ensure high-quality remote learning experiences, we will standardize the use of a single online learning platform and develop a common, coordinated set of guidelines for teachers to follow when using the platform with students. Zoom and Google Classroom will be utilized for these purposes. Parents will be provided with all necessary login and/or account set up information by email and physical mail.

Live (virtual/in real time) instruction with teacher, pre-recorded lessons, and other instructional resources will be utilized to deliver the curriculum remotely. Teachers will be available to students every day in real time, which will also allow for check in opportunities.

Physical materials may also be made available to students and families if needed, in order to adequately support student progress. This request would need to be made in advance to the homeroom teacher.

Assistive Technology listed on the IEP will be provided to students that are participating in remote learning. 1:1 aides will follow the remote schedule of the student they are assigned to.

In the event a student is quarantined, out sick, or is being isolated, they will have access to their Google Classroom assignments that are posted by their teacher.

### **School Closure**

In the event of a school closure requiring in-person students to transition to remote learning, families will be notified of the closure, and referred to a Zoom schedule and Google Classroom information, which will be sent separately.

Related services would transition to Zoom. Service providers will contact individual families to coordinate schedules.
