This weekend, we received notification that two staff members on our Brewster campus tested positive for COVID-19. The students and staff who were in close contact with these individuals have been notified and are now isolating.

Staff and families of students who are believed to have been in contact with these staff members have been notified. Green Chimneys will be testing and isolating all individuals who may have had exposure. If you have not been notified, it is because it has been determined you are not at risk.

We are coordinating with the Putnam County Department of Health and are closely monitoring the situation with all individuals on campus.
