To Our Green Chimneys Families,

We have received notification that three staff members on our Brewster campus have tested positive for COVID-19. These individuals were last on campus on Sunday, Wednesday and Thursday of this week; all who had close contact have been notified and are now quarantining.

As a reminder, all day students will continue with remote learning on Monday, January 11th and Tuesday, January 12th. Returning residents will be tested and stay within their dorm cohorts, participating in classroom instruction via Zoom while awaiting test results.

We are coordinating with the Putnam County Department of Health and are closely monitoring the situation with all individuals on campus. We continue to follow all safety guidelines and have determined, along with the Department of Health that we do not need to suspend in-person instruction at this time.

Parents should continue to monitor their child each day for symptoms of COVID-19, which could include fever, loss of taste or smell, headache, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, fatigue, congestion or runny nose, body aches and/or nausea.
